

ShowRunner Points Options

You can award points to the top teams in any type of class (sorting, penning, or roping) using one of the options described below. The points awarded will be shown on the Final Class Payout, points reports, and each rider's invoice.

AWARD POINTS TO THE TOP 10

This setting will award points to each rider on the top 10 teams in the final class standings, as shown in the table below.

1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th	8 th	9 th	10 th

Example:

If you have a class with at least 10 teams, 10 points will be awarded to each rider on the 1st place team in the final class standings, 9 points will be awarded to each rider on the 2nd place team, and so on until the 10th place team.

AWARD 1 POINT FOR EVERY 1 TEAM YOU BEAT

This setting will award each rider on a team 1 point for every team they beat in the final class standings. Teams with no times in the first round will not be awarded any points.

Example:

If you have a class with 10 teams, points will be awarded as shown in the table below.

SHOWRUNNER POINTS OPTIONS

AWARD POINTS USING 'MNSCHA POINTS TABLE'

This setting will award points to each rider on the top teams in the final class standings, based on the total number of teams in the class. One point and one winning place will be added for every 5 (or part of 5) teams in the class, as shown in the table below.

Example:

If there are 112 teams in the class, you divide by 5 to find the number of points and places to be awarded. In this case, 112 divided by 5 equals 22.4, which gets rounded up, so 23 points will be awarded to each rider on the 1st place team, 22 points will be awarded to each rider on the 2nd place team, and so on up until the 23rd place team.

AWARD POINTS USING 'RSOA OR RSTPA POINTS TABLE'

This setting will award points in the top ten round only, according to the table below.

SHOWRUNNER POINTS OPTIONS

AWARD POINTS USING 'USTPA POINTS TABLE'

This setting will award points to each rider on the top teams in each round and also to each rider on the top teams in the final class standings. The number of points awarded is based on the number of teams in the round or class, according to the table below.

If you have a class with 50 teams in the first round, 30 teams in the second round, 20 teams in the third round, and 10 teams in the final round, points will be awarded as shown in the table below.

AWARD POINTS USING 'MULTI-ROUND 10/20' RULES

This setting will award points to each rider on the top ten teams of each round and also to each rider on the top twenty teams in the final class standings.

Example:

If you have a class with at least 20 teams, points will be awarded as shown in the table below.

DOUBLE POINTS

This option can be used in combination with any of the points methods described above to double all points.

How to Set It Up

1. Enter the phrase "double points" anywhere in the class title (*Figure 1*).
2. Check the Award Points box in the Payout and Points section of the Class Details.
3. Select the points method you would like to use to calculate points.

SHOWRUNNER POINTS OPTIONS

CASCADE POINTS TABLE

This setting will award points to each rider on the top teams in each round, based on the number of teams in that round. Double points will be awarded to each rider on the top teams in the final class standings (average), based on the total number of teams in the class. The number of winning places and the number of points awarded are based on the table below.
